Module 2 focuses on wires and terminals Module 3 emphasizes PCB, Coating, Encapsulation and Staking Module 4 focuses on Through-Hole Modules 5 focuses on Surface Mount Module 6 focuses on Inspection Each module consists of 8 classroom hours The certification is valid for 24 months.
Who Should Attend	Candidates for this training include assembly technicians with a minimum of one (1) year solder experience.
Career Potential	The career potential for this position is an assembly level position leading to high level solder technician and repair/rework position.
